- B. Principal Update
 - 1. Thank yous

- C. Treasurer Update
 - 1. Based on school needs and conversations with Librarian Andria Sharp, Suzanne Ruesch made a motion to increase the book vending machine budget to \$2250 (*a \$250 increase), Mira Kapur seconded the motion, all were in favor and the motion passed.
 - 2. Balance at the beginning of February was \$33,813.46, and with expenses outlined in the budget, the ending balance was \$33,485.26

 - 1. A PTSO Impact Report was prepared by Katie Sanders and Suzanne Reusch; it included the following information about the money raised by PTSO as well as what it was spent on:
 - a) \$9,483 raised during Fuel the Fund
 - b) \$4,749 raised through business sponsorships
 - c) \$1,749 raised through community rewards programs
 - d) Roughly \$1100 raised through restaurant nights
 - e) \$1,300 for the book vending machine (a book for every student initiative)
 - f) \$784 for recess enrichment (playground equipment)
 - g) \$853 for educational resources (grade level subscriptions)
 - h) \$565 for art and music programs at school
 - i) \$1,370 for classroom supply grants
 - j) \$139 on targeted materials for students
